This is with reference to the above notification and the notification no. PT/2020/15/WKS/102016/G-396/GH1 dated 10th June 2020 issued by Government of Gujarat amending the condition no. 14 for Scheduled of Port Charges (SoPC) for applicability of escalation in all rates by annual Wholesale Price Index with effect from 1st May every financial year.

In this regards, considering the Weekly Statistical Supplement Vol. 37 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2022 issued by Reserve Bank of India (https://rbi.org.in/Scripts/WSSViewDetail.aspx?TYPE=Basic&PARAM1=4/22/2027),

Wholesale Price Index (WPI) is observed at 14.5 % year-on-year. Hence, the rates applicable previously for FY 2020-21 is hereby escalated by 14.5 % w.e.f. 1st May 2022, and the revised rates are enclosed herewith for ready reference and implementation. All other terms and conditions of above referred notifications related to Scheduled of Port Charges (SoPC) will remain same and applicable accordingly.
