<sup>1</sup> HEIGHT – Refers to the height declared by the vessel, measured vertically from the water-line to the highest point of the vessel including its cargo, structure or equipment on board. If there are extendible structures and the extended height exceeds the heights of its cargo or fixed structures or equipment on board, the highest point shall be the maximum height attainable by these structures when fully extended. The height must be verifiable with the appropriate plans or documents carried on board the vessel.

<sup>2</sup> Arms means – (a) firearms, air-guns, air-pistols, stun guns, electronic dart guns, automatic guns, automatic pistols, guns or any other kind of gun from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged or noxious fumes or noxious substance can be emitted, and any component part of any such arms; (b) bayonets, swords, daggers, spears and spearheads; and (c) such weapon, accessory, or other article or thing, as specify to be arms for the purposes of the Arms and Explosives Act (Cap. 13) or any part thereof;
